When explaining a process, students should outline the steps in a logical order.</p> <p>Monday: Edison - Thomas Edison said that he didn't make mistakes, he just learned 10,000 ways <u>not</u> to make a light bulb. Describe a mistake you made and the lesson you learned from it.</p> <p>Tuesday: Extreme Weather - Choose an extreme weather condition or a natural disaster such as a tornado or a volcanic eruption. Explain its causes and effects.</p> <p>Wednesday: Gaming - Explain how to play your favorite video or board game to someone who has never played it before.</p> <p>Thursday: Pay It Forward - What is one thing you would like to do—either now or in the future—to make the world a better place?</p> <p>Friday: Wild Kingdom - Of all the animals wild or domesticated, write about your favorite. Include interesting facts about this animal in your essay.</p>	<p>Week 3 - Writing Prompts: In your opinion paragraph, be sure to state your opinion and back it up with facts and reasons. Ideas should be organized and supported by details.</p> <p>Monday: Five-star - What is the best book you have ever read and what made it so amazing?</p> <p>Tuesday: Survival.
